



PROJECT SUMMARY

SUMMER FOOD ACCESS

Kaukau 4 Keiki was established in the summer of 2021 as a result of the strong advocacy of former First Lady Dawn Ige to address the gap in food access for keiki in Hawai'i. This program is supported by the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Summer School Food Services, the Hawai'i Child Nutrition Program, and a team of private and public partners, including Vibrant Hawai'i. Kaukau 4 Keiki provided free weekly meal kits for breakfasts and lunches during the summer months with a focus on reaching children (Ages 0-18) in rural communities statewide.

During the regular academic year, thousands of students receive free or reduced-priced meals, but during the summer, many schools are unable to continue their meal program due to staffing and logistical challenges. For students living in rural areas, transportation challenges or conflicting family work schedules make picking up Department of Education Grab and Go meals difficult.

In an economy that already imports 90% of its food, the Kaukau 4 Keiki project provided keiki and teens access to healthy meals, especially in low-income, rural areas across the state. In-state service providers include Mālama Kaua'i on Kaua'i, Kahumana Food Hub & Organic Farms on O'ahu, Maui United Way on Maui and Lāna'i, and Vibrant Hawai'i on Hawai'i island.

Vibrant Hawai'i, in partnership with local businesses and 35 community groups, led Kaukau 4 Keiki on Hawai'i Island for six weeks from June 19 through July 28, 2023. Registrations exceeded expectations, and numerous sites reached their maximum capacity within the first hour, underscoring the need in our Hawai'i Island communities.

4,000 keiki picked up weekly meal kits, which were designed according to USDA food guidelines and included over 5 pounds of locally sourced fruits and vegetables, bread, shelfstable milk, and protein. There was a purposeful emphasis on incorporating local produce as part of the Summer Food Service Program: a federally-funded, state-administered program that reimbursed Vibrant Hawai'i for the meal kits.



HOW IT WORKED

UNIFIED ACTION

Hawai'i Foodservice Alliance, LLC, Hilo Products, Inc., Hawai'i Institute of Pacific Agriculture, and Ho'ōla Farms brought pallets of canned goods, milk, and boxes of locally-grown produce every week to 14 centralized drop-sites across the island. These deliveries were an incredible orchestration of logistics that sourced pantry items and produce for 56,000 meals a week.

Once the pallets of food supplies were delivered, community groups worked quickly to break down bulk supplies, transport items to 35 locations islandwide, and assemble meal kits for distribution.

The ability to mobilize a project of this scale in just three short weeks indicates the caliber of leadership within each of our communities, as Site Leads coordinated teams of hundreds of dedicated volunteers.

Through this project, Hawai'i Island has again demonstrated the strength and depth of our community, public and private partners, and our commitment to building a resilient and vibrant community.

FOOD SECURITY LOCAL PRODUCE

Kaukau 4 Keiki is a demonstration of cross-sector collaboration that unites community, non-profit and faith organizations, local farmers and businesses, and County and State government agencies.


Volunteer Hikaloi (Self-Reflection)



Volunteers By Generation






